- Simonds 13 Bath Arms Hotel. Bath Street, demolished 1967.
- Simonds 14 Cumberland Hotel. St.Mark's Road, Totterdown, still trading.
- Simonds 15 Lord Chancellor. Easton Road, demolished early 1960's.
- Simonds 16 Black Horse. Cheltenham Road, now a restaurant.
- Simonds 17 Punch Bowl. Old Market Street, still trading.
- Simonds 18 White Lion, Colston Avenue, still trading.
- Simonds 19 Trenchard Street, still standing but no longer a pub.
- Simonds 20 White Hart, Lower Maudlin Street, still trading.
- Simonds 21 Merchants' Arms, Merchants' Road, Hotwells, still trading.
- Simonds 22 Prince of Wales, Tower Lane, demolished 1976.
- Simonds 23 Hit or Miss, Easton Road, now the Jolly Roger.
- Simonds 24 Queen's Head, East Street, Bedminster, now a hairdressers.
- Simonds 25 Bathurst Hotel, Bathurst Terrace, now the Louisiana.
- Simonds 26 Three Horse Shoes, Old Market Street, now the Long Bar.
- Simonds 27 Glass House Hotel, Lawrence Hill, demolished 1969.
- Simonds 28 Paxton Arms, Easton Road, demolished late 1960's.
- Simonds 29 Phoenix Hotel, Wells Road, Totterdown, demolished 1972.
- Simonds 30 Three Tuns, Easton Road, demolished 1970's?
- Simonds 31 Greyhound, Lodge Causeway, Fishponds, still trading.
